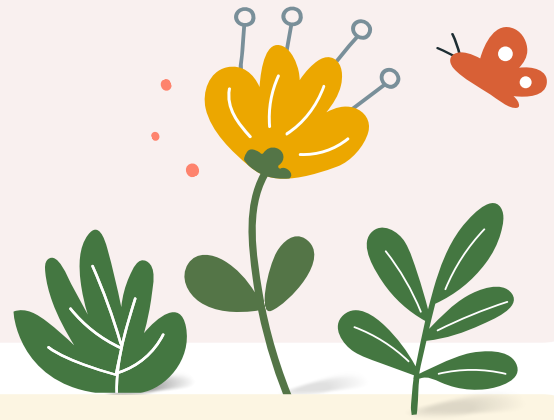


BUDDY'S BOOK NOOK APRIL
